Prof. Bruce German

Prof. J. Bruce German, professor and food chemist at the University of California's Department of Food Science and Technology, will be a keynote speakers at the joint IDF/DIAA Dairy Science World Series Conference (DSWS) – Functional Dairy Foods 2009 – in Melbourne on February 24-25, 2009.

Prof. German's presentation will be on 'Delivering dairy foods to the diversity of the human condition'.

An international expert in the field of human nutrition, Prof. German has authored and co-authored more than 250 papers on lipids and food, metabolism and metabolite measurements and food functions, and patented various technologies and applications of bioactive agents.

His research articles over the past 10 years rank in the 'Top 10 Most Cited in Agriculture', according to ISI HighlyCited, a website put together by journals publisher, Thomson Reuters.

Prof. German joined the faculty at the University of California, Davis, US, in 1988, after completing his PhD at Cornell University. In 1997 he was named the first John E. Kinsella Endowed Chair in Food, Nutrition and Health.

In addition to teaching, Prof. German serves;

- as senior scientific advisor at the Nestlé Research Center in Lausanne, Switzerland and**
- Head of the Scientific Board of Lipomics Technologies Inc. in California.**

His research interests include:

- the structure and function of dietary lipids,**
- the role of milk components in food and health, and**
- using metabolic assessment to personalise diet and health..**
