**WHAT:**

The Willunga Farmers Market is. . .

- a weekly Market featuring food from the Fleurieu
- a vehicle for promoting the produce from the region
- a meeting place for locals of the Fleurieu, near and far
- an incorporated body
- a not-for-profit community event

WHEN:

every Saturday of the year, rain, hail or shine from 8-12.30pm.

WHERE:

the car park of the Alma Hotel at the entrance to Willunga.

WHO:

the producers –

vegetable growers, dairy farmers, orchardists, livestock producers, cheese-makers, bakers, cooks, compost makers, . . .

the customers -

anyone who enjoys good food, which potentially means everyone. Regular Market shoppers come from the South Coast, Adelaide and the southern suburbs. At peak times up to 2,000 shoppers visit the Market

the members -

currently 600+ members support the Market and receive discounted shopping & other benefits for annual fee of \$30

the committee -

with members drawn from local producers and Market supporters, the Willunga Farmers Market committee, sets the general direction of the Market

Market Manager -

part-time employee, Vardy Hirst oversees the general management of the Market and is the face of the Market every Saturday
